(today Cementos Argos S.A.), as an attorney and went on to become International Legal Manager, where he has participated in projects such as the acquisition of CINA (Haiti) in 1997, the sale of La Jagua (Coal Mine) in 2004-2005, the acquisition of Concrete Express and Southern Star (USA) in 2005, the acquisition of the Port in Houston and RMCC (USA) in 2006, and the acquisition of Vensur (Surinam) in 2008, to name a few. Until June, 2012 he was Vice-President of Corporate Affairs of Cementos Argos S.A. He is currently Vice-President of Corporate Affairs of Grupo Argos S.A.
